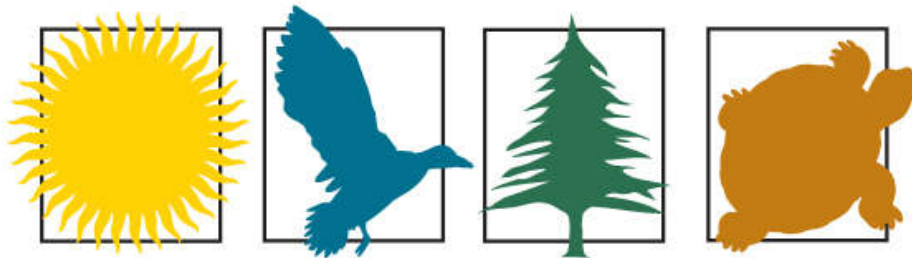

Place a star on the map of the trails you are hiking on. (Staple to the back of the booklet if the booklet is your own copy. Please don't staple it if it's a library copy)

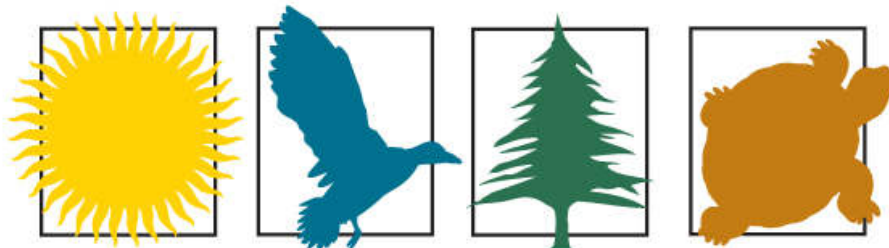
